

Tools and materials required:

- envelope pattern
- fabric
- adhesive fabric interlining
- rotary cutter
- cutting mat
- ruler
- iron
- all purpose glue



Instructions:

1. Print the envelope pattern;

From the PDF file, print the pattern in a A4 paper sheet and cut out the envelope.

2. Cut the fabric and the interlining;

Cut the fabric and the interlining in a rectangle, slightly larger than the envelope pattern.

3. Join the fabric and the interlining;

Facing the back of the fabric towards the adhesive side of the interlining, iron the two pieces together. Make sure the iron is set for high temperature and no vapor. Iron as many times as needed to make sure that the two fabrics are well glued together. Let it cool down, until it gets a little bit rigid.

4. Cut out the fabric envelope;

Place the fabric piece on the cutting mat and, on top, place the envelope paper pattern.

With the rotary cutter and the ruler, cut out the envelope from the fabric piece.

5. Fold the envelope;

Using the iron again, fold the envelope, pressing hard on the folding lines.

6. Glue the envelope;

To finish, spread some glue on the flaps and apply some pressure, to make sure it closes securely.

7. That's it!
